## Cost of living tax credit

### Adjusted net income

Enter your net income from line 23600 of your return.

Enter the total of amounts claimed on line 24400  
and line 25000 of your return.

Enter the amount claimed for foreign income from line 25600  
of your return that is exempt under a tax treaty.
